Christmas Performance of Baubles!

On Monday 11th December Year 3 children from Walsh Junior School and **Grandparents only** are invited to this event as it is our final dress rehearsal and we only have limited space in the hall. Tickets will be allocated strictly on a first come, first served basis and there is a maximum of two tickets per family.

For the main performances, as we only have a limited space in the school hall and we want to cater for as many families as possible, we are running three separate performances of the Christmas play and a *maximum of two tickets will be allocated per family for one performance of their choice* (subject to availability). There is no charge for the tickets.

Our first full performance on Tuesday 12th December is for families and pre-school children. If a pre-schooler attends they will either need their own ticket or they will need to sit on a parent's lap. *Pre-schoolers are not permitted on any other day.*

Wednesday 13th December – 9.15am. Adults only, no children

Thursday 14th December – 1.30pm. Adults only, no children. Our Christmas raffle will be drawn at the end of this performance.
