They **DO NOT** accept:

- Carpets, rugs and mats (including bath, shower and toilet mats)
- Soiled, painted, ripped or wet clothing
- School uniforms with and without logo (the school will gladly accept these if they are kept separate).
- Corporate clothing and workwear
- Textile off cuts, yarns or threaded material

Please note that, due to limited space, we cannot accept donations before Monday 4th March. Bag2School are collecting our donations on Wednesday 6th March so we are unable to accept any further donations after 3pm on 6th March.
