Applying for a Junior School space or for Year R for September 2020

Year Two parents will need to apply for a Year Three space for their child for September 2020, even if they intend for their child to go to Walsh Junior School. It is imperative that you apply before the deadline of January 15th or you may not be offered one of your schools of choice. The on-line system will open on November 4th and you can change your choice of schools any time up to 15th January.

You will need to apply online if you have access to the Internet via the following website:

www.surreycc.gov.uk/admissions - if you pay your Council Tax to Surrey County Council

www.hants.gov.uk/admissions - if you pay your Council Tax to Hampshire County Council

It does not matter if you are applying on the Hampshire website for a Surrey School or vice versa. After the closing date, the application information will be shared between the two counties.

If you need a paper copy of the application form for a postal application, please let the school office know. Similarly, if you need assistance completing the paperwork please let the school office know.

You can download the 'ParentComms' app to your mobile device to receive notifications about your application.

Once you have submitted your application you will receive a confirmation email.

Important dates to remember:

4th November 2019 - You can apply online for a school place from this date.

15th January 2020 - Closing date for applications. However, the councils welcome early applications

16th April 2020 - School offer letters are posted first class. If you applied on-line you will be sent an email in the evening with the outcome and you can also view your school offer online.

30th April 2020 - You must confirm, by this date, whether you wish to accept or decline the place you have been offered.

Please note that if you are applying for a sibling to start in September 2020, and you have a child in our school or Walsh Junior School, you should tick the box which states that your child is a sibling as you will be given sibling priority status.

Parent Interviews

On Wednesday 6th November (late slots) and on Monday 11th November (earlier slots) you will have the opportunity to meet with your child's teacher to discuss your child's progress in school.

Our on-line booking system is open for you to make an appointment to see your child's teacher. Appointments can be made through Scopay. If you have problems logging on, please contact the school office.

Year R children and children who are new to our school and those that have not used the system before have been sent home with a letter containing a unique ID which will enable parents to access our booking system. Please contact the school office if you need any help.

If you are unable to use our on-line system for any reason, please contact the school office who will endeavour to help you.

PTA Questionnaire

We have recently send home a questionnaire for parents to complete regarding our PTA and the activities they propose undertaking.

We would be extremely grateful if you could complete these and return it by Friday 8th November as we are keen to understand how we can get more people involved.
